

Create a world in which all children have the opportunity for an education.



In December 2005, Canadian athletes and a photographer visited a school in a small community in Niger, where they saw 30 children sharing one pencil in a classroom with few books and fewer supplies, no electricity and no running water. This experience inspired a group of Canadians to launch Pencils for Kids, an **all-volunteer charity** dedicated to partnering with communities to deliver support to students, build schools and libraries, provide classroom resources, and develop self sustaining education, training and income generating programs.

Programs

Since 2006, Pencils for Kids has partnered with the community of Liboré, Niger, shipped over 20,000 kg of school supplies and medical equipment, received 10,400 soccer balls from One World Futbol and opened 3 schools, a Library and Education Centre.

Scholarships for Girls provides books, uniforms, food and tutoring for girls.



Over 300 scholarships since 2009. First ever girls from Liboré graduate and enter university

Farmers of the Future teaches primary students to irrigate, plant, market their crops and invest their earnings.



500 students and 30 teachers participate, 80 mothers run income generating gardens beside the schools

The **Coopers Sewing Centre for Girls** aims to provide sewing skills and literacy training for girls who are no longer in school.



150 girls received training since 2008

Kindergarten classrooms have opened to give pre-schoolers a head start.



14 kindergartens launched with more than 5000 students benefitting since inception
